GERRY NOLAN QUALIFIES WITH FLORIDA DIVISION OF ELECTIONS
AS WRITE-IN CANDIDATE
FOR FLORIDA'S 6TH CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT

John G. "Gerry" Nolan has qualified as a write-in candidate for Florida's 6th congressional district on November 3, 2020.

In America, twenty-seven of the four hundred thirty-five U.S. House of Representatives are from the great State of Florida. One person is elected to represent the interests of 6th Congressional District running along northeast coast from the Canaveral National Seashore through Daytona Beach up to southern portions of St. Augustine and as far inland as St. John's river basin. In the last election over five million dollars were contributed to the Republican and Democratic Candidates in this race. Gerry Nolan has 193 days to produce more write-in votes than any of the other of the five qualified candidates at time of this release.
